



INTERNATIONAL TEAM OFFICIAL LICENCE 2024

OBLIGATIONS OF TEAM OFFICIALS

By applying for an International Team Official Licence, I acknowledge the rules of IFSC and commit myself to act according to these rules.

> In particular:

- I understand and abide by the regulations and rules of the sport and observe the principles of good sportsmanship;
- I acknowledge and accept that I cannot hold a Team Official accreditation together with a Media Accreditation; I understand that failure to comply with the above may result in the withdrawal of both accreditations at the discretion of the IFSC Event Delegate;
- I will accept, subject to the official appeals procedure, the decisions of the official judges without question or protestation and exercise self-restraint at all times;
- I will treat other Team Officials, Athletes, officials, and others involved in the practice of the sport with full and due respect at all times, both during and outside a competition;
- I will not be involved in betting in respect of IFSC competitions and will comply with the IFSC Code of Conduct, and the IFSC Code of Conduct on Sports Betting Integrity.

> In connection with Anti-Doping (as per the IFSC Anti-Doping Rules):

I recognise that, as an Athlete Support Personnel, I am subject to the jurisdiction of IFSC, or of any National Federation, or of any member or affiliate organization within any National Federation (including any clubs, teams, associations, or leagues), for purposes of anti-doping.

In addition:

- I expressly acknowledge the right of the World Anti-Doping Agency (“WADA”) and any other anti-doping organisation to perform, on behalf of IFSC, out-of-competition tests on Athletes I may be in charge of.
- I expressly acknowledge the right of IFSC and WADA to start disciplinary proceedings against me or to join such proceedings as a party in connection with any disciplinary offence including involvement in doping cases.
- I will refrain from facilitating, providing, and encouraging others to use prohibited substances and methods described in the IFSC Anti-Doping rules and World Anti-Doping Code as well as transporting the above substances.

> In connection with IFSC RELATIVE ENERGY DEFICIENCY in Sport (REDs) HEALTH CERTIFICATION POLICY

- I hereby agree that the Athletes I may be in charge of shall comply with the IFSC REDs Health Certification policy. In case of failure to comply with such policy, I accept that sanctions and restriction to access competitions might be applied to the Athlete and/or myself and/or the National Federation.

> In connection with image use and IFSC communication initiatives

As a participant in an event authorized or recognized by the IFSC, I hereby declare confirm my agreement with the following:

- I agree to be filmed, photographed, or otherwise recorded while performing my duties at IFSC competitions and more generally in the context of the authorised or recognised IFSC events (e.g. interviews) and I grant IFSC a royalty-free licence to use such photographs or audio-visual recordings without limitation of time or territory, for the promotion of Sport Climbing and to authorize third parties (in particular its broadcast partners and IFSC



sponsors) to use such photographs or audio-visual recordings in their coverage of IFSC events and in editorial use, through any media (known or to be known);

- I agree to support IFSC, when possible, in the promotion of its competitions and, more globally, of Sport Climbing, as well as other networking opportunities (e.g. co-commentating, attendance to workshop, etc.);

- I undertake not to publish social media posts for the purposes of demonstration or any form of political, religious or racial propaganda. They must be dignified and not be discriminatory, offensive, hateful or defamatory. In particular, when using social and digital media, I will not:

- i. intrude upon the privacy of others;
- ii. infringe any intellectual property rights, or other rights of the IFSC or any other person or organisation;
- iii. disclose any confidential information or another person's or organisation's private information;
- iv. interfere with the competitions or the ceremonies of the competition or with the responsibilities of the IFSC or other entities that are part of the organisation of the event; or
- v. violate security measures for the safe conduct of the competition.

> In connection with the prevention of the manipulation of competitions

As a member of the National Federation and/or a participant in an event authorised or recognised by my National Federation and/or IFSC, I hereby declare as follows:

I acknowledge that I am bound by, and confirm that I shall comply with, all the provisions of the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, IFSC Code of Conduct, and IFSC Rules in Competition Integrity as published on the IOC and IFSC website.
