

IFSC WORLD RANKINGS 2026

Counting Competitions and calculation factors

1. **Purpose**

This document identifies competitions during the 2026 season counting toward the *IFSC World Rankings* and sets out season-specific and competition-specific factors used for the calculation of *World Ranking* points.

2. **Counting Competitions & Status Factors**

Table 1 (*Counting Competitions and Status Factors*) identifies competitions counting toward the *World Rankings* for each relevant discipline, and the *Status Factors* assigned by the IFSC for each competition.

3. **Continent Strength Factors**

Table 2 (*Continent Strength Factors*) sets out the *Continent Strength* factors to be used in the calculation of *World Ranking* points for *Continental Events* held in the 2026 season
