

## **CONTINENTAL FEE SYSTEM**

*Approved by the Executive Board*

This document defines the Continental Fee System for Continental Councils and is intended as an official reference for the application of Calendar, Service, and Registration Fees for events sanctioned by World Climbing and its Continental Councils.

The purpose of this document is to ensure transparency, consistency, and harmonization in the application of fees across all continents, including Europe, Asia, Pan-America, Oceania, and Africa. It establishes a standardized structure and template for the definition of Events Fees and Athletes and Team Official Registration Fees.

This document applies to all Continental Championships, Continental Series, Youth and Para events, and other sanctioned competitions as specified herein. The honorarium of Officials is not included in this document, as it is regulated separately under the Financial Regulations.

Continental Councils are responsible for confirming and applying the fees within their respective areas of activity in accordance with this framework. Any deviation from the present Fee System must be formally communicated and approved by World Climbing.

This document shall serve as the official reference for publication, communication to Member Federations, and implementation for the **2026-2028 seasons** and is effective starting from the 2026 season of events. The document may be subject to annual review.

### **GENERAL PROCEDURES**

Continental Councils are responsible for:

- Invoicing LOCs for continental events hosting rights (ref. EVENTS) before the start of the season. Payment of the relevant invoices is a mandatory requirement for the confirmation of the event in the calendar.
- Invoicing NFs for registrations of Athletes & Team Officials (ref. REGISTRATIONS) after conclusion of the continental events. Registrations are due regardless of the Teams' effective participation in the events.
- Paying the appointed Officials according to the Financial Regulations in force (Annex VII – Officials Honoraria and Annex VIII – Continental Financial Procedures).

The Office shall assist the Continental Councils in the implementation of the above-mentioned procedures.

The fees indicated for Africa, Oceania, and Pan-America are subject to revision based on the development of events and the financial capacity of the respective regions. Any adjustments will be communicated by the relevant Continental Councils and approved by World Climbing in accordance with the applicable regulations.

### 3. ATHLETES CANCELLATION POLICY (Europe)

#### Introduction

The number of athletes attending the World Climbing Europe sanctioned events is a key information to manage the running of the competition professionally. The event preparation starts weeks before the event date, and it is based on the number of competitors. For this reason, Member Federations are required to comply with the registration deadline as set in the Rules.

However, it has been observed that the number of registered athletes to the competition is often significantly higher than the number of attending competitors. To limit such circumstances, an extra fee for repeated athletes' no-show is introduced from 2025 on.

#### Policy

National Federation registered athletes = X  
National Federation competing athletes = Y

Where:

- Registered athletes (X) are the athletes that are registered on the World Climbing result system at the registration deadline
- Competing athletes (Y) are the athletes that obtain a result on the same competition

When:

- X is higher than Y

Then:

- The Federation will receive an extra invoice at the end of the season based on the difference between X and Y, with a tolerance of 10%. The amount of the cancellation fee/athlete is the same of the registration fee set in the World Climbing Fee System for that specific event.

Per type of competition (Europe Series /Europe Youth Series /Europe Para Series; Europe Championship; Europe Youth Championship; Europe Para Championship), the following formula will be applied to calculate:

$$\text{If } \left( \frac{X-Y}{X} \leq 10\%; 0\text{€}; \left( \text{RoundUp} \left( \left( \left( \frac{X-Y}{X} \right) - 10\% \right) \times (X-Y); 0 \right) \times \text{"Registration Fee"} \right) \text{€} \right)$$

#### **4. INTERNATIONAL LICENCES**

All team members willing to register for World Climbing-sanctioned events must hold a valid International Licence. More information on the licences is available [here](#).

World Climbing is responsible for invoicing the NFs for the International Athlete (Team Official) Licences. Payment of all licences whose status is “Confirmed” in the Result Service is due, regardless of the effective participation in the events.
