

PARA CLIMBING WORLD RANKING

1. Introduction and glossary

In 2025, World Climbing introduced for the first time the Para Climbing World Ranking. The principles which regulate the Para Climbing World Ranking are outlined in the chapter below. The World Ranking Regulation shall be always read in conjunction with Para Climbing Competition Regulation, available on the World Climbing website.

World Climbing Events = Para Climbing World Championship and Para Climbing World Series

2. World Ranking principles

- 2.1. Each athlete will only appear in one Sport Class ranking. Athletes are not eligible for multiple Sport Classes rankings
- 2.2. The World Ranking will include the Para Climbing World Series Para Climbing World Championship
- 2.3. The points that will be awarded to the athletes are displayed in Table 1. Table 1 will be used for the Para Climbing World Championship and any Para Climbing World Series. For the avoidance of doubts, all World Climbing Events will release the same amount of points to the winner
- 2.4. Where two or more competitors have the same placing (ranking) in the General Result of a competition, the ranking points awarded to each tied competitor will be averaged for the tied places
- 2.5. The World Ranking will include the sum of points achieved by the athletes for the last six (6) consecutive World Climbing Events. It should be noted that the ranking is not connected to the six last individual results, but to the six last World Climbing Events.
- 2.6. For the avoidance of doubts, the event number counts will not take into consideration if an athlete attended the event, or not. Example:

- 2.7. The number of Sport Classes which will be open on each World Climbing Event will be irrelevant for Ranking purposes. All World Climbing Events, irrespectively of the number of Sport Classes open, will be considered for the calculation above
- 2.8. The Sport Classes which do not meet the minimum registration requirements will not award any ranking points. For the avoidance of doubt, the Sport Class which will be combined into another one will not award any ranking points
- 2.9. For World Ranking purposes, the ranking of Combined Sport Classes will be re-calculated to consider only the athletes from the Sport Class which meet the minimum registration requirements
