Athletes compete for a maximum of 100 points across the 2 stops
50% awarded in Shanghai / 50% awarded in Budapest

The sum of points determines who qualifies for Paris 2024

The IFs are responsible for determining the rules related to the points system of their respective sports.

Tie-Break: A) In case of a tie between athletes within each event ranking, athletes receive the points according to that position. The points are not shared between tied athletes.
 B) In the case of a tie between athletes with the same number of points in the Series Ranking at the end of stop 2, the position will be resolved in favor of the athlete who ranked the highest in Budapest. If a tie cannot be broken via criteria number 1, and if the unbroken tie concerns the Paris Qualification quota placement, it will be broken via a sport specific criteria (Seeding: World Ranking) defined by each IF.
