



**IFSC HONORARY AWARD
Terms of Reference**

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1. Pursuant to Article 10.2.1.11 of the IFSC Statutes, the title of Honorary President of the IFSC and Honorary Member of the IFSC is awarded by the General Assembly to individuals who have made significant contributions to the IFSC, either through their involvement in IFSC bodies or by supporting its development.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Only past IFSC Presidents may be awarded the title of Honorary President.
- 2.2. The following individuals are eligible to be awarded the title of Honorary Member:
 - 2.2.1. Individuals who have significantly contributed to the IFSC through participation in IFSC bodies.
 - 2.2.2. Individuals who have significantly contributed to the IFSC through general engagement in the sport's development.
- 2.3. Nominees do not need to be necessarily affiliated to an IFSC National Federation.
- 2.4. Nominees must not have any history of sanctions or actions detrimental to the IFSC or its members.

3. NOMINATION PROCESS

- 3.1. Nominations for Honorary President or Honorary Member may be proposed by:
 - 3.1.1. The Executive Board;
 - 3.1.2. Any IFSC National Federation; in this case the nomination must be supported by two (2) other IFSC National Federations.
- 3.2. The names of nominees will be proposed for approval at the General Assembly.

4. RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF HONORARY MEMBERS

- 4.1. Honorary Members:
 - 4.1.1. May attend the General Assembly; the attendance package is covered by IFSC.
 - 4.1.2. May not vote at General Assemblies.
 - 4.1.3. May not stand for election in the Executive Board, Continental boards, or be appointed to Commissions, unless otherwise specified in other applicable regulations.
 - 4.1.4. May not be IFSC employees.
 - 4.1.5. May not represent or act on behalf of the IFSC unless given an official mandate by the Executive Board.
