1. **IFSC Climbing World Cups quotas**
 - 1.1. Currently eligible *National Federations* may, within the published deadlines, register *Team Officials* at any *World Cup* event in the capacity and number set out in Table 1 (*Team Officials*)
 - 1.2. Currently eligible *National Federations* may, within the published deadlines, register for each gender category and discipline of the relevant *World Cup* event as follow:
 - 1.2.1. Up to two (2) currently-eligible competitors;
 - 1.2.2. In addition to the individuals covered above, up to an additional four (4) competitors where the *National Federation* is the host nation; and
 - 1.2.3. an additional number of competitors where the *National Federation* has an *Additional Quota* in a relevant gender category and discipline, up to the number of that *Additional Quota*.
 - 1.3. The *Additional Quota* for each *National Federation* in each gender category and discipline will be determined by the number of competitors from each *National Federation* ranked between 1st and 40th in the relevant *World Ranking* as at the end of the previous year using the values set out in Table 2 (*Additional Quota*).
 - 1.4. The IFSC will publish annually the calculated *Additional Quota* in each gender category and discipline for each relevant *National Federation* not later than 31 January each year. Any subsequent additions/deletions from this list will require the approval of the IFSC Executive Board and will be published on the IFSC website and communicated directly to all *National Federations* by the IFSC Sport Department.

2. **IFSC Climbing World Championships quotas**

- 2.1. Currently eligible *National Federations* may, within the published deadlines, register *Team Officials* at the *IFSC Climbing World Championships* in the capacity and number set out in Table 3 (*Team Officials*)
- 2.2. Currently eligible *National Federations* may, within the published deadlines, register for each gender category and discipline of the *IFSC Climbing World Championships* as follow:
 - 2.2.1. Up to two (2) currently-eligible competitors;
 - 2.2.2. Any current World Champion, in the Discipline for which they are champion;
 - 2.2.3. an additional number of competitors where the *National Federation* has an *Additional Quota* in a relevant gender category and discipline, up to the number of that *Additional Quota*.
- 2.3. The *Additional Quota* for each *National Federation* in each gender category and discipline will be determined by the number of competitors from each *National Federation* ranked between 1st and 40th in the relevant *World Ranking* as at the end of the previous year using the values set out in Table 4 (*Additional Quota*).
- 2.4. For the avoidance of doubts, the Additional quotas that will be granted at the IFSC Climbing World Championships will be always fixed to forty (40), respecting the maximum number of quotas per National Federation. If any National Federation will reach the maximum number of additional quotas (as set out in Table 4), the remaining quotas will be allocated to the following ranked athletes (i.e. 41st rank, 42nd rank, etc.).
- 2.5. The IFSC will publish annually the calculated Additional Quota in each gender category and discipline for each relevant National Federation not later than 31 January each year. Any subsequent additions/deletions from this list will require the approval of the IFSC Executive Board and will be published on the IFSC website and communicated directly to all National Federations by the IFSC Sport Department.

3. **IFSC Climbing Youth World Championships quotas**
 - 3.1. Currently eligible *National Federations* may, within the published deadlines, register *Team Officials* at the *IFSC Youth World Championships* in the capacity and number set out in Table 5 (*Team Officials*)
 - 3.2. Currently eligible *National Federations* may, within the published deadlines, register for each gender, age category and discipline of the *IFSC Youth World Championships* up to three (3) currently-eligible competitors;

4. **IFSC Para Climbing Events quotas**
 - 3.1. Currently eligible *National Federations* may, within the published deadlines, register *Team Officials* at the *IFSC Para Climbing Events* in the capacity and number set out in Table 6 (*Team Officials*)
 - 3.2. Currently eligible *National Federations* may, within the published deadlines, register for each gender, age category and discipline of the *IFSC Para Climbing Events* up to five (5) currently-eligible competitors
