

**INTERNATIONAL ATHLETE LICENCE 2026  
OBLIGATION OF NATIONAL FEDERATION**

By applying for an International Athlete Licence, I, National Federation, acknowledge the *World Climbing Competition Rules*. As a National Federation whose competitors apply for an International Athlete Licence I undertake:

To inform World Climbing immediately of any change of the Athlete's details given on the World Climbing Result System;

To provide all whereabouts information concerning the Athlete required by the *World Climbing Competition Rules* or requested by World Climbing in and out of competition;

To inform World Climbing immediately of any adverse analytical finding from doping tests of any Athlete and of disciplinary proceedings in connection with such;

To start, upon request of World Climbing and without delay, disciplinary proceedings against any Athlete who has been subject to an adverse analytical finding from a doping test and to keep World Climbing fully informed about the progress of any such proceedings;

To ensure that the Athlete has been physically examined by a qualified medical practitioner and declared fit to compete in international Sport Climbing competitions;

To ensure that the Athlete has been screened for REDs and to submit Medical Data via REDCap for the Athlete, as detailed in the REDs Health Screening Rules;

To constantly monitor the physical fitness of the Athlete, in order that the Athlete does not take part in competitions for which their health and fitness is in doubt;

To ensure that the Athlete is fully and properly insured for personal accident and medical risks, including for repatriation.

**Important Notice**

All Athletes (including youth Athletes, refer to the *World Climbing Competition Rules* for the category list) competing in World Climbing international Sport Climbing competitions must be in possession of an International Athlete Licence issued by World Climbing;

Those Athletes for whom their belonging National Federations have not applied for an International Athlete Licence or those who have not been registered for the relevant competition will NOT be allowed to compete in World Climbing sanctioned events;

The National Federation agrees to comply with the *REDs Health Screening Rules*. In case of failure to comply, the National Federation accepts that sanctions and restriction to access competitions might be applied to the Athlete and/or the National Federation;

The validity of each International Athlete Licence expires at the end of the current calendar year;

Each year, before the first competition of the season (or before the first competition of the season in which their Athletes intend to participate), every National Federation shall apply for new licences or for the renewal of existing ones, in writing using this form. The forms shall be completed following all instructions included in the World Climbing Result System;

The 2026 International Athlete (Team Official) Licence annual fee amounts to EUR 40 / Athlete (Team Official), for both new and renewed licences. Such fees shall be paid upon receipt of the relevant invoice within the established due date; All licences whose status is "Confirmed" in the World Climbing Result Service are included in the above-mentioned invoice, regardless the effective participation of the Athlete, and are subject to the payment of the relevant fee.

**The Licence will be considered valid only when its status on the World Climbing Results Service appears as “Confirmed” after both the National Federation and the Athlete have confirmed it.**
