

**INTERNATIONAL TEAM OFFICIAL LICENCE 2026
OBLIGATION OF NATIONAL FEDERATION**

By applying for an International Team Official Licence, I, National Federation, acknowledge the World Climbing Competition Rules. As a National Federation whose competitors apply for an International Team Official Licence I undertake:

- To inform World Climbing immediately of any change of the Team Official details given on the World Climbing Result System;
- To inform World Climbing immediately of any disciplinary proceedings against the Team Official;
- To start, upon request of World Climbing without delay, disciplinary proceedings against any Team Official who has been involved in any doping case or illegal betting case and to keep the World Climbing fully informed about the progress of any such proceedings.

Important Notice

- All Team Officials wishing to perform their duty in World Climbing international Sport Climbing competitions must be in possession of an International Team Official Licence issued by World Climbing.
- Those Team Official for whom their belonging National Federations have not applied for an International Team Official Licence or those who have not been registered for the relevant competition will NOT be allowed to perform the following duties in World Climbing sanctioned events:
 - a) Submit appeals;
 - b) Access the isolation zone, Team Official zone and other restricted areas of the Field of Play;
 - c) Freely access to the competition venue.
- Team Officials will be requested to inform World Climbing of their exact roles, such as Head of Delegation (Team Manager), Physio/Medic, Coach;
- The validity of each International Team Official Licence expires at the end of the current calendar year;
- Each year, before the first competition of the season (or before the first competition of the season in which their Team Officials intend to perform their duties), every National Federation shall apply for new licences or for the renewal of existing ones, in writing using this form. The forms shall be completed following all instructions included in the World Climbing Result System;
- The 2025 International Athlete (Team Official) Licence annual fee amounts to EUR 40 / Athlete (Team Official), for both new and renewed licences. Such fees shall be paid upon receipt of the relevant invoice at the end of the event season;
- All licences whose status is “Confirmed” in the World Climbing Result Service are included in the above-mentioned invoice, regardless the effective participation of the Athlete (Team Official), and are subject to the payment of the relevant fee.

By clicking “I hereby confirm to have read, understood and agreed to the International Team Official Licence” on the World Climbing Result Service, you are undersigning this document.

The Licence will be considered valid only when its status on the World Climbing Results Service appears as “Confirmed” after both the National Federation and the Team Official have confirmed it.
